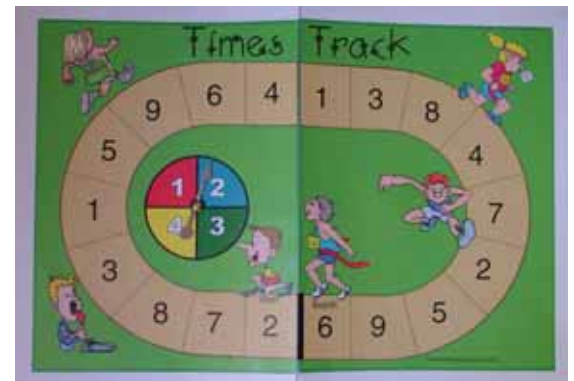
These fun, interactive games were created to help students review and master essential math and language skills. The full color games in each packet are designed for students to play with a partner or in a small group. They are great activities to engage students during learning center time, small group instruction and when they are finished with other assignments. Also, there are enough games in one packet for the whole class to play at the same time. Divide the class into groups and give each group one of the games. Every 10-15 minutes rotate the games to a different group. This is a wonderful way to review and build essential math and language skills while the students are having fun!

How to Make and Store the Games

The games in each packet come in a variety of colors so you can easily keep the pieces for the same game together. Games last much longer if they are laminated first, then cut apart. The board games are in two halves. They need to be trimmed at the center then taped together. They can be folded in half and will fit in a gallon size baggy.

Attach the directions on the outside of the baggy with clear contact paper. Cut apart the cards and place them in the baggy along with some moving markers. Some good moving markers are different shapes of erasers, plastic toys, pencil toppers and game pieces from old commercial board games.

Some of the games include a number wheel. Metal spinners can be purchased at most teacher stores or you can attach a paper clip with a paper fastener to the center of the wheel.



Dozens of games can be easily stored in a shoe box or tub so students can have ready access to them.
